Driving via Hwy. 16

- Take exit #184 (CR- JK/KE) South towards North Shore Dr.
- Continue to follow CR- KE (go about 4 miles)
- Turn RIGHT on Cottonwood Ave. (go about 0.3 miles)
- Arrive at 1055 Cottonwood Ave. (third building on the LEFT)

Driving via I-94

- Take exit #287 (Hwy. 83) toward Hartland
 - Travel NORTH on Hwy. 83 (go about 2 miles)
 - Turn RIGHT on CR- KE/North Shore Dr. (go about 0.8 miles)
 - Turn LEFT on Cottonwood Ave. (go about 0.3 miles)
 - Arrive at 1055 Cottonwood Ave. (third building on the LEFT)

PROGRAM CHOICES

HITTING DEVELOPMENT

- Teaches proper hitting mechanics: stance, stride, swing path and finish to all ages
- High School players also learn hitting to the opposite field, curveballs, and bat control
- Mental approach stressed to all ages

PITCHING DEVELOPMENT

- Proper pitching mechanics and pitcher "mentality"
- Control, accuracy, and changing speeds will be taught at all age levels
- High School baseball players also learn curves, change-ups, cut fastballs, split finger, and pitch selections

FIELDING DEVELOPMENT

- Proper stance and pre-pitch movement
- Fielding routine ground balls: directly at "you," glove-side, back-hands, slow rollers.
- Drills- to improve all-around infield skills
